

Helsinki Map of Attractions






Ateneum

Also known as the Ateneum, it is the most famous art museum in Finland and the center of Finnish art (Map-1,2)

- Central Park Contains four nature protection areas, the park is a recreation center as well as home to several animal species
- Design Museum A museum devoted to Finland's rich and diverse design history, the building is a notable architectural attraction in itself (Map-1,2)
- Esplanadi Picturesque urban park and promenade featuring several pubic art pieces, a restaurant and outdoor live music venue
- Finlandia Hall A multi-purpose venue that serves as an important architectural structure as well (Map-1,2)
- Finnish National Museum Formed as the State Historical Museum, it started out as a combination of the collection of several other museums (Map-1,2)
- Finnish submarine Vesikko A restored World War II submarine that serves as an informative museum of Finland's wartime history (Map-1)
- Gallen-Kallela Museum A fabulous museum featuring works by the esteemed Finnish painter Akseli Gallen-Kallela
- Helsinki Cathedral A neo-Classical style cathedral built in 1830. It is located on the northern side of Senate Square (Map-1,2)
- Helsinki Zoo In island zoo that features nearly a thousand different plant species along with over a hundred-fifty animal varieties (Map-1)

Hietaniemi

A cemetery located on the shores of a popular tourist beach (Map-1,2)

- Kiasma Home of the Finnish national gallery's contemporary art collection. The building itself is an important architectural landmark (Map-1,2)
- Linnanmäki Amusement Park **13** Serving the public since 1950, the park features a wide variety of modern rides as well as traditional classics dating back over 65 years (Map-1)
- Mannerheim-Museo A museum built in honor of Baron Gustaf Mannerheim, who was once the Marshal of Finland (Map-1,2)
- Mannerheimintie Street Helsinki's main thoroughfare, it is the site of many of the city's most important structures (Map-1)
- Market Square 16 A center of food and produce in Helsinki. Offers a wide selection of fresh produce, local delicacies, and food establishments (Map-1,2)
- Natural History Museum A part of the Finnish Museum of Natural **17** History, it features a diverse collection of exhibits covering various aspects of nature (Map-1,2)
- Old Market Hall Oldest food market known for vendors that serve some of the best Finnish gourmet delicacies
- Olympic Stadium 19 A center of sports, culture, entertainment and tourism in Finland, it was the site of the 1952 Summer Olympics (Map-1)
- Parliament House 20 The parliament building of the Finnish government with a visitor's center and a library (Map-1,2)

Pihlajasaari Recreational Park A former villa that now serves as a popular recreation area and historical site

- Senate Square Part of the oldest section of Helsinki, the square is the site of many of the city's most significant landmarks (Map-1,2)
- Seurasaaren Ulkomuseo A seasonal open-air museum that features an impressive array of historic Finnish cottages, farms, and estates (Map-1)
- Seurasaari An open-air museum located on a lush and tranquil island just off the coast of Helsinki (Map-1)
- Sibelius Park & Monument A park built in honor of Jean Sibelius, the most esteemed composer in Finland's history (Map-1,2)
- Suomenlinna Island One of Finland's most popular attractions, drawing more than 900,000 visitors every year (Map-1)
- Temppeliaukio Kirkko One of Helsinki's most unique buildings. Unveiled to the public in 1969, it was designed by Timo and Tuomo Suomalainen (Map-1,2)
- Uspenski Orthodox Cathedral The largest Orthodox Church in Western Europe and one of the best examples of Russian influence on Finnish culture (Map-1,2)
